



Department of Mines and Petroleum Dangerous Goods Company Innovation Award 2010

As part of the WA Road Transport Industry Awards 2010, Resources Safety will be presenting a company award to recognise innovative initiatives in dangerous goods transport safety. The aim is to stimulate the implementation of creative safety initiatives throughout the road transport industry and recognise those achievements through this new award.

There are many elements of safe handling and transport of dangerous goods in Western Australia that have been instigated through the experience of specialist carriers. These include stable tank design, packaged load restraint, managing incompatible goods, specialist emergency incident response, driver training initiatives and explosive mixing vehicle designs. The company that receives this award will demonstrate the high standards that are achievable and to which all transport operators can strive.

ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARD

Companies directly involved with dangerous goods road transport, including explosives transport companies, are invited to nominate for this award.

This award recognises excellence in developing and implementing a solution to an identified dangerous goods transport safety issue. Entries for this award may include, but are not limited to:

- An engineering innovation to address vehicle design, tanker/ container/ restraint systems, handling/ dispensing issues;
- Training initiatives;
- New ways of recording and dealing with safety deficiencies;
- Improved safety management of dangerous goods, including security risk substance initiatives; and
- Improved emergency response management.

Company's nominated must address the following:

- What was the particular dangerous goods transport safety issue?
- What solution was developed to address the issue? How original and innovative was the solution?
- What improvement in dangerous goods transport safety has resulted from implementing your company initiative? Demonstrate this by appropriate means and substantiate the improvement.
- What potential is there for the solution to have broader application across industry?
